# *NOTES ON CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT LIST*

## **NAMETAPES:**

**Small and large names are required plus initial badges for sports kits (these are ordered by School)  
(All items brought to School MUST be named and all towels looped for hanging purposes)**

1. All boots and shoes should be marked with your child's name. Trainers, Wellingtons, shoes and games boots should have their name marked in indelible ink, this will need renewing frequently. Daily Boarders should send Matron an extra 12 tapes for marking 'Match Kit'.
2. Please ensure that your daughter's name is on all personal items.
3. Loops should be provided in the middle edge of a long side of bath towels.
4. There will be a charge of £50 on the first term's account for the use of linen for the duration of your daughter's stay at Beeston.
5. No jewellery allowed except for a watch, clearly marked and a simple cross and chain or similar.
6. All shoe cleaning equipment will be provided by the school.
7. Trunks will ONLY be returned at the end of the Spring and Summer Terms.
8. All Free-time clothing must be colour fast, machine washable, tumble-drier proof and kept to a minimum.
9. NO make-up at all, including fake tanning products.
10. Roll on deodorants only.
11. Tuckboxes and Trunks can be ordered through 'Bus Stop'.

## Free-time Wear

Houseparents will give specific instructions as to free-time wear, but we have to advise that space is very limited and we would appreciate appropriate clothing, jeans, T'Shirts, Hoodies would be an essential part of life at Beeston.
