Macmillan Cancer Support and Norfolk and Norwich University Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust are working in partnership to transform a disused ward at Cromer and District Hospital into a state-of-the-art cancer care and support centre.

The new centre, due to open in July 2021 will enable more people to access cancer treatments and support closer to home. Currently most people from the North Norfolk area have to travel to Norwich or beyond for cancer treatment. This can mean long days, travelling on limited public transport, feeling unwell.

The North Norfolk Macmillan Centre in Cromer will include:

- 6 chemotherapy treatment chairs with capacity to treat up to 36 patients every day.
- 3 new clinic rooms and 2 new minor procedure rooms, creating an additional 10,000 outpatient appointments annually & space for new cancer diagnostics.
- A Macmillan cancer information and support centre
